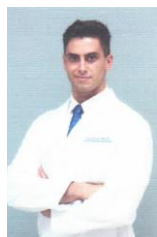

Dr. Daniel Yacoob is a dual-degree Oral Surgeon and is board eligible. Dr. Yacoob grew up in Southern California and after ten years in San Francisco has relocated to Chicago to pursue a career in full scope private practice OMFS.

Dr Yacoob studied psychology and biology at McGill University and later attended UCSF School of Dentistry where he graduated in 2012. He completed his OMFS training at UCSF where he also earned his MD.

Dr Yacoob brings his extensive experience in the specialty to the practice. His fields of clinical interest are dento-alveolar surgery, implantology, ambulatory anesthesia, pediatric and adult craniomaxillofacial surgery including reconstruction, TMJ, orthognathic surgery, trauma and pathology. Dr. Yacoob holds hospital privileges and takes trauma call at Advocate Christ Medical. Beyond the confines of private practice, Dr. Yacoob especially enjoys getting involved with community service and global health outreach initiatives.



Dr. Russell A. Baer graduated from the University of Illinois School of Dentistry in 1985 and completed a two-year general practice residency at the University of Chicago. Dr. Baer is a past clinical associate professor at the University of Chicago where he taught implant dentistry in the General Practice Residency and Maxillofacial Prosthodontics program and conducted clinical research in implantology and reconstructive dentistry. This clinical research has included a single tooth immediate load studies using Replace and Replace Conical Connection.

Dr. Baer is an active member of the Academy of Osseointegration and the International Congress of Oral Implantology. He has written numerous articles and lectured both nationally and internationally on implant dentistry. His passion for implant dentistry led him to the former Soviet Union, where he founded the Chicago Center for Advanced Dentistry and serves as academic director. The center is the leading training center of oral implantology and advanced dental techniques in the region and has offices in Moscow, Kiev, Vilnius, Almaty and Mumbai, India. Through this program, many American dentists have had the opportunity to teach and practice implant dentistry in this region of the world.
